As a member of the Senate Banking & Insurance Committee I respectfully request that you ask Scott Wallace, President of Citizens Property Insurance Corporation, to appear before the committee. There are many new policies and procedures that Citizens has implemented since the end of the 2011 legislative session. These policies, and changes that will take place on January 1, 2012, are the cause of great concern among my constituency.

I have received a torrent of phone calls, e-mails and letters from homeowners and insurance agents requesting that I find out why Citizens is conducting business in ways that, in some cases, are inconsistent from one homeowner to another. For example, I have received complaints that roof replacement rules appear to be applied inconsistently. Additionally, I have received complaints about the following: increased premiums for replacement cost value as compared to actual cost value, the manner in which carports, screen porches and related structure coverage has been dropped, customers with active sinkhole claims having their non-sinkhole coverage dropped, and other issues. I do not have a good answer for my constituents.
